# C2C Outcome Areas -Impact and Bright Spots

C2C is committed to lifting up best practices using data-informed decision making that get results for kids no matter race, economic background, or zip code. Below are some snapshots of our current work in our eight outcome areas.



#### SCHOOL READINESS

Supporting efforts for more sustainable investments in early childhood education systems to increase equitable access for all families.



#### POST-SECONDARY ENROLLMENT

Launched Change Network, engaging with UA and PCC leaders with a focus on incorporating family and student voice.



### **EARLY LITERACY**

3,378 K-3rd students and 146 teachers impacted by district-wide shifts in early literacy practices and adding 4 more teams next school year.



#### POST-SECONDARY COMPLETION

Developing strategies to support students' successful completion of math requirements needed for their chosen career improvement projects.



### MIDDLE SCHOOL MATH

Working with multiple school districts to implement and scale targeted professional development strategies for middle school math teachers.




#### **CAREER ATTAINMENT**

Working with employers to develop flexible paid work experiences with positive mentoring and on-site support that result in employment opportunities.



### HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION

Compared to 2021, there was 142% increase in number of REC-enrolled youth who received a high school credential.



### OPPORTUNITY YOUTH RE-ENGAGEMENT

Over 1,100 Opportunity Youth enrolled in re-engagement services to re-connect to education and career pathways.
